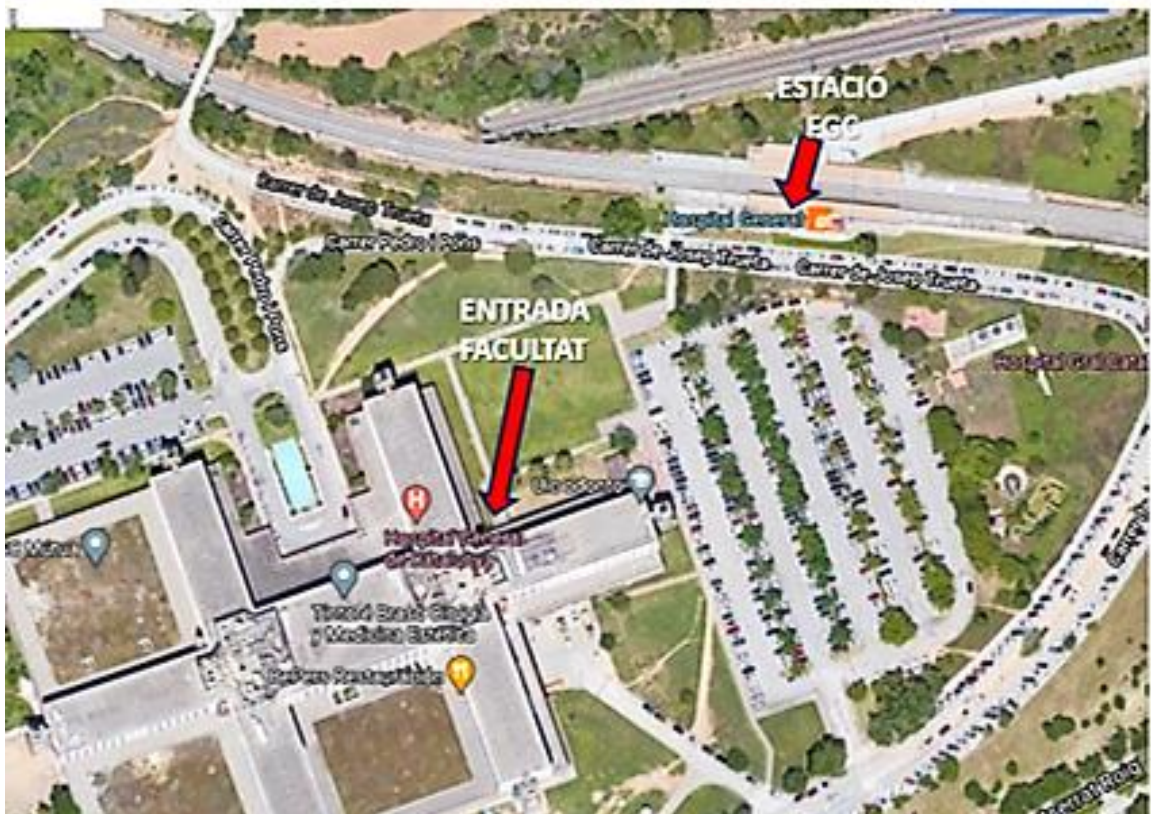
11.30 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.: Break
