

Objective

To students with excellent academic records who are enrolled in UIC Barcelona and during the academic year reside or are going to reside in one of the student residencies the university has an agreement with; Bonaigua or Pedralbes.

Six annual aid of €2,000 each will be awarded.

Academic requirements

Students who want to access a UIC Barcelona accommodation aid must:

- Enrol in UIC Barcelona for a minimum of 60 credits
- Live in a student residence that has an agreement with UIC Barcelona
- Have passed all the credits from the previous year and have at least an average mark of 7 in both higher secondary school and their university degree.

How do I apply for the aid?

The aid application will be through the online [form](#), with the following documentation attached:

- Photocopy of national ID card (DNI)/ NIE/Passport
- Letter of motivation
- Academic record from the most recent year of study
- Admission letter from student residence
- Collective certificate for the whole family
- Income statements of all members of the household
- Other income certificates not included in the income statement (pensions, disability, unemployment benefits, etc.)
- Large or single-parent family card (if applicable)

Calendar

The deadline ends on June 30. Decision before July 15

Payment of the aid:

For the renewal of the aid, the student must maintain the academic requirements, resubmit the application and attach the updated documentation.
