At UIC Barcelona we build and learn responsibly. A good example of this is the Vertical Workshop, a competition held annually among students from first to fifth year of architecture. During the first week of the course, students, in teams and together with professors, guide, design and develop projects with materials such as cardboard, fabric and wood. The projects are developed on a real scale, which favors the students, who put themselves in the shoes of the builder. Each year the jury decides on a theme with a social purpose. Companies donate sustainable materials to the university as a symbol of support for this workshop and the promotion of sustainable development in architecture.
